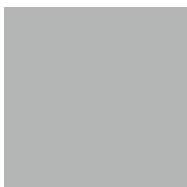
A bit About Concrete

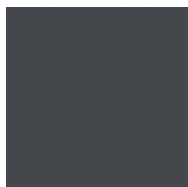

- Use a floor wax polish to maintain the shine and protect the top
- Use cement or grout to fill in any damage to the top, reseal and polish

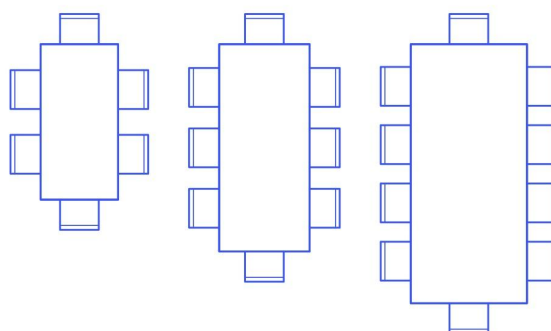

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FAQ:

Q - How thick is the top?

A - Standard thickness 35mm.

Q - Is the top polished?

A - Top is polished smooth and sealed with industrial strength sealer.

Q - What material are the legs made of?

A - The legs are made from steel with a standard powder coated finish.

Q - Is it heavy?

A - The tabletops are solid concrete and range from about 100kg - 300kg depending on the size.
