




### A bit About Concrete


#### How to care for concrete tops:

- Use cement or grout to fill in any damage to the top, reseal and polish



### FAQ:

- Q How thick is the top?
- A Standard thickness 35mm.
- Q Is the top polished?
- A Top is polished smooth and sealed with industrial strength sealer.
- Q What material are the legs made of?
- A The legs are made from steel with a standard powder coated finish.
- Q Is it heavy?
- A The tabletops are solid concrete and range from about 100kg 300kg depending on the size.
